The meeting was called to order at approximately 3:01pm.

Meeting Minutes – April 20, 2020

Motion made by Norm Bogen to approve the April 20, 2020 minutes with one revision, seconded by David Light, motion carried unanimously.

<u>Review of Financials – April 2020</u>

Treasurer Lopez provided an overview of the Balance Sheet for review to determine if the information she has drilled down to is enough data for presenting in the Finance Committee meeting and at Board meetings – The member agreed that the format is acceptable moving forward.

Treasurer Lopez provided an overview of the Profit & Loss Report and described the formulas she embedded with thresholds that will flag (highlight) line items that fall within the formularies for review immediately.

Norm Bogen expressed that the Bad Debit Expenses line item has never been studied by the Finance Committee and questioned why it is increasing. Veronica explained that because we are looking at a month (April) which is our 2nd quarter billing month it is always higher. Discussed a process to track bad debt expense to determine the percentage we are collecting. Noted that we currently we have \$186K in assessments and fees over 90 days.

Financial Questions submitted via email

Reviewed the list of question and answers submitted to Treasurer Lopez. Moving forward the Q & A information will become part of the official Finance Committee minutes.

Discussed the current Collection Policy. Colleen will send the Finance Committee the policy for review and possible revision. Colleen will also send out the threshold information on Reserve Study items.

Discussed GL 5711 for painting common area item. This should have been funded by the Reserve not out of operations. Colleen will discuss reallocation. Also discussed what makes up GL 5048 – Office Expense
