## Introduction:

The Rancho Vistoso community runs primarily on volunteers and we are always looking for fresh perspectives, ideas and additional help. If you are looking for a direct way to influence the direction of your community, there is a rewarding way to accomplish that through personal involvement in Vistoso Community Association's (VCA) various committees. Applications are available at the VCA office, on <a href="https://www.RanchoVistosoHOA.com">www.RanchoVistosoHOA.com</a> as well as at the VCA monthly meetings.

The only specific requirement for committee membership is that the applicant be a full-time resident homeowner in good standing. Members are not compensated for their time and effort and receive no personal gain being involved in a Committee. Volunteers must be familiar with the Association Articles, By-Laws, CC&Rs and Design Guidelines. Meetings are usually held in late afternoon or early evening. Meeting attendance is required.

## **Existing VCA Committees:**

<u>Architectural/Landscape Review Committee</u> – monthly review and approval of architectural and landscape plans that require submittal for exterior renovations on residential buildings or structures.

<u>Compliance Committee</u> – monthly review of residential violations that do not adhere to the Association rules and regulations outlined by the CC&Rs Articles and By-Laws.

<u>Financial Review Committee</u> – participate in annual reviews and distribution of the Rancho Vistoso Community Association budget and reserves.

<u>Communications Committee</u> – volunteers prepare and/or review appropriate Association documents and publications released to the Rancho Vistoso community.

<u>Annual Nominating Committee</u> – volunteers to manage the Board of Directors election process. This is a short-term commitment (November through March) to oversee the call for candidates, ballot preparations, ballot counting and announcing election results.

<u>CC&Rs/By-Laws Update Committee</u> – volunteers review the Association documents to meet current and changed State/Federal statutes specifically addressing Homeowner Associations.

<u>Parks & Landscaping Committee</u> – be the voice for our common areas and amenities. Frequent walkabouts and discussion about equipment and common area status.

<u>Ad Hoc Committees</u> – there are numerous opportunities for short term and specific project volunteers. This is ideal for the volunteer that cannot make a monthly commitment, but wants something shorter term! We need you!
