B. Report on Meeting with Wendy Ehrlich, Esq.

Matt Wood reported that he and the General Manager met with Wendy Ehrlich to review the process of amending the CC&Rs. Ms. Ehrlich commented that a lot of work still needs to be completed on the revised document and suggested that the association should consider amending the 75% required to change the document to a simple majority rather than change the full document. This would give a clear indication on how successful the association would be in getting the necessary votes to amend the entire document. Both Wendy Ehrlich and Mark Sahl recommended that the vote for the CC&Rs and the Board of Directors be mailed separately since the voting requirements are different. This topic will be placed on the next agenda for further discussion to get input from the two members that were unable to attend.

VI. New Business

A. Calendar Deadlines for CC&R Rollout

Late summer into fall was discussed to meet with sub-associations to introduce the benefits of changing the CC&Rs.

B. 2023 Budget Request

The commercial parcel billings and annexation & declaration rights projects were discussed along with costs related to the amending the CC&Rs. Management was requested to get costs for a separate mailing for the CC&Rs amendment.
