Motion failed with two votes in favor and two opposing votes cast by Joe Affinati and Lyle Vandermyde.

VIII. Variance Request – 12805 N. Bandanna Way – Awning

A motion was made by Susan Wood and seconded by Sheryl Forte to deny the awning request since the awning does not meet the Architectural Landscape and Review Committee Guidelines. The motion carried with three votes in favor and one opposing vote casted by Joe Affinati.

IX. Honey Bee Canyon Monument & Landscaping Architectural Request

The committee reviewed the architectural & landscaping request to enhance Honey Bee Canyon Estates monument & common area landscaping. A motion was made by Joe Affinati and seconded by Sheryl Forte to approve the Honeybee Canyon Monument architectural request with the stipulation of the landscape lighting not to exceed the 3000k Kelvin temperature. Motion was unanimously approved.
